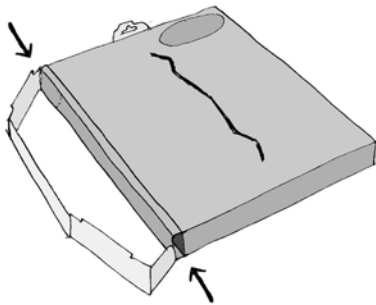


# MINI JAMMERS®

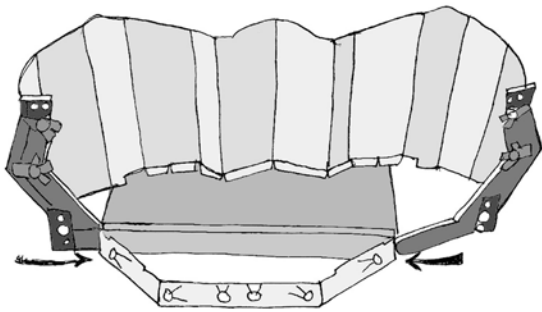
~ Before you begin ~

**You will need a glue stick or white glue to complete the setup.**

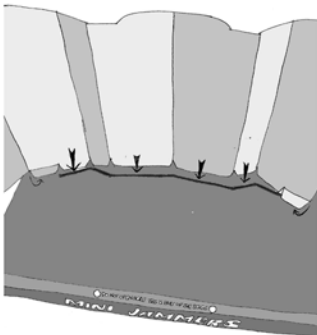
- (1) Lay the box face down. Insert the ends of the front stage strip into the large side slots in the box as shown.



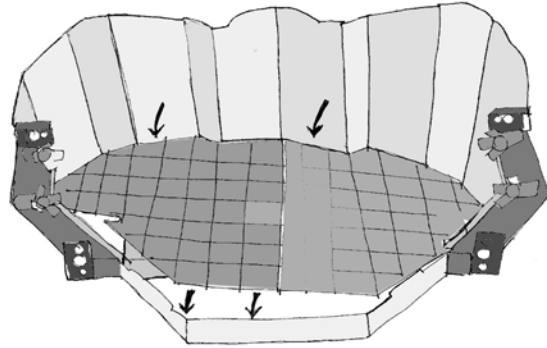
- (2) Unfold the silver stage backdrop. Insert stage sides into the same side slots in the box as shown.



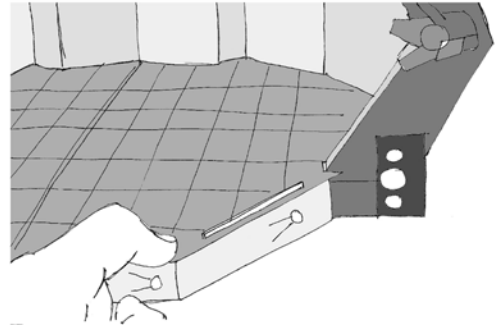
- (3) Insert the silver tabs into the slit in the back of the box as shown. Fold the outer tabs forward to keep the backdrop in place.



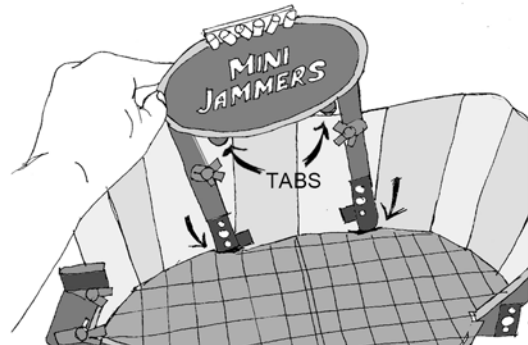
- (4) Unfold the stage floor and press it into place as shown.



- (5) Make sure the stage floor is flat and fits in place as shown. Tape down if needed.



- (6) Insert the bottom of the Mini Jammers sign into the floor slits as shown. Tuck the tabs behind the stage backdrop to hold the sign in place.



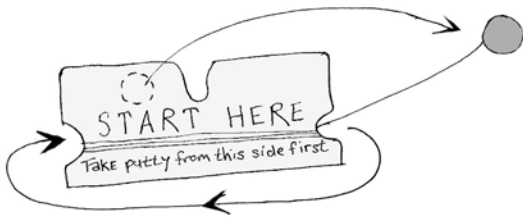
## \* IMPORTANT \*

### About Invisible Thread

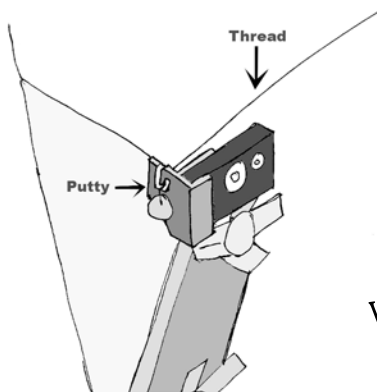
Two key things to remember when working with invisible thread:

- (1) It's very delicate and can break easily. Handle it gently.
- (2) Although we show thread in the following diagrams, it is invisible unless placed against a white background or in bright direct light.

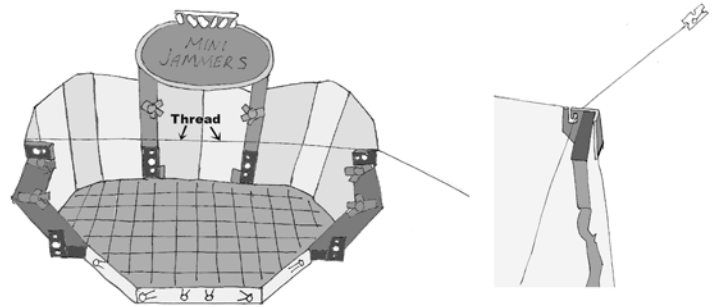
- (7) Remove one thread card from the clear box. Gently unstick the putty next to the words "Start Here". Carefully unwrap the thread from the card. Do not remove the second piece of putty.



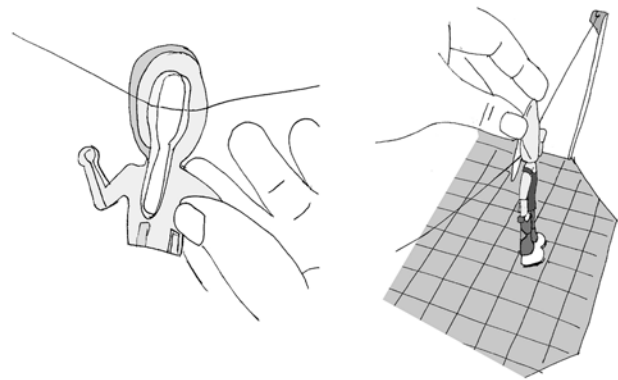
- (8) Firmly press the free piece of putty onto the left side of the stage as shown. Make sure the thread passes through the slit.



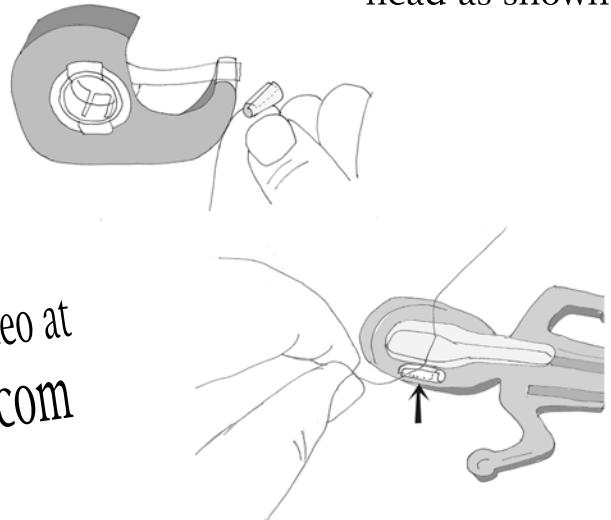
- (9) Pull the thread across the stage and insert it through the holder slit on the right side of the stage as shown.



- (10) Keeping the thread taut over the stage, hook the back of the Jammer's head over the thread as shown. The Jammer should be in the middle of the stage. Make sure the thread is all the way under the hook so the Jammer does not fall off.

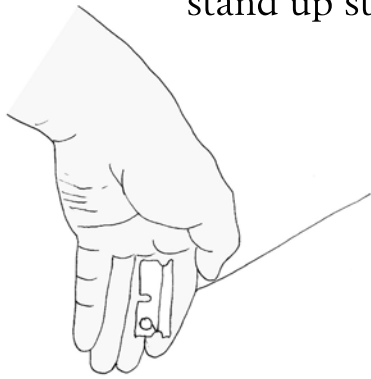


- (11) If the Jammer falls off the thread when dancing, make a small tape loop and place it in the back of the Jammer's head as shown.

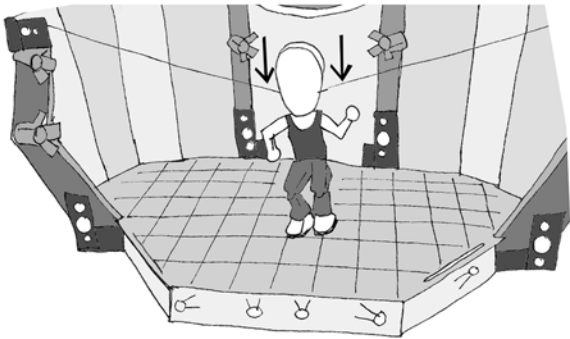

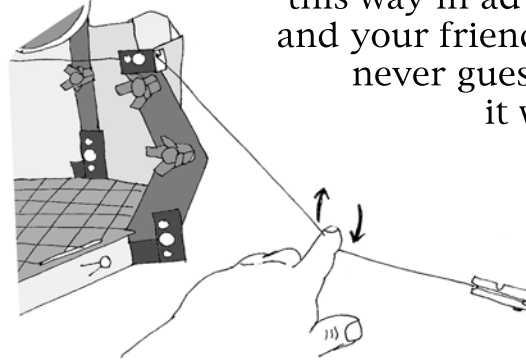
(12) Hold the card and putty in one hand as shown. Keep the thread taut across the stage, and the Jammer will stand up straight.



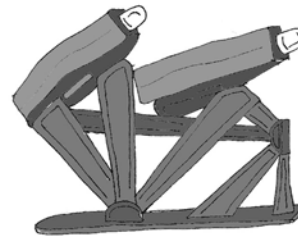
(13) To make the Jammer dance, move your hand a little closer to the stage and then farther away. Tapping your hand against your leg is a good way to make the Jammer dance well. Turn on your favorite dance music, and move your hand back and forth to the beat - single or double time! Watch the instructional video to learn all kinds of tricks.



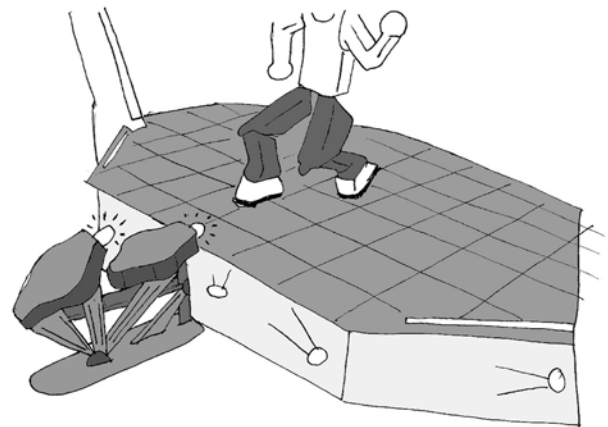
(14) Another easy way to make the Jammer dance is to attach the thread card to the table as shown. Make sure the Jammer's knees are bent to touch the stage floor. Tap on the thread to make the Jammer dance. Set the Jammer up this way in advance, and your friends will never guess how it works!



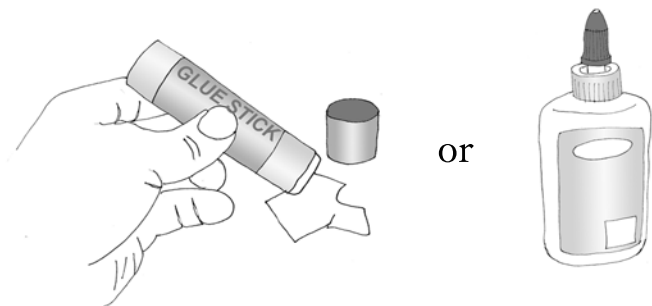
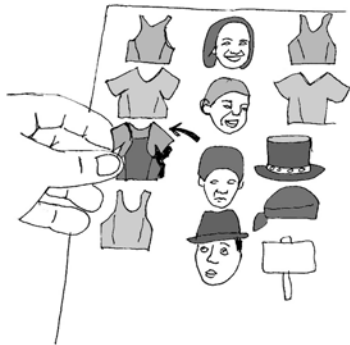
(15) Attach the lights to the light stand as shown: colored light on the lower stand and white light on the upper stand. Turn on the light by pulling back on the top switch.



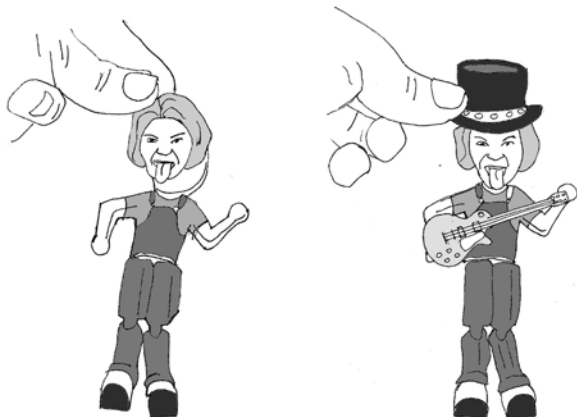
(16) Place the lights against the front middle of the stage as shown.



(17) Customize your Jammer's face, clothing or accessories! Choose your favorite accessories from the included sheets and stick them to the Jammer using a glue stick or white glue. Make sure to place the shirt high enough that it does not interfere with the movement of the Jammer's legs.

(18) Want to put your own face on the Jammer? Here's how. First, take a crazy photo of your face, and upload it to [minijammers.com](http://minijammers.com). Then follow the instructions to size and print the new face. Cut out the face and stick it onto the Jammer using a glue stick or white glue.
